

Prices



It is sometime since our last bulletin and much has happened. Current prices have stayed robust and the view of most mills has been that there is no benefit trying to chase volume at the expense of prices. In July the new Chinese owned British Steel and Arcelor both announced a price increase of £30/t on heavy sections and this has been followed by British Steel announcing another £30/t from September. Hollow sections will also definitely see a price rise as imported dock stock cannot be replaced until October due to European quotas. We believe that prices will rise over the next few months but there are many different elements to take into account so we recommend that you keep in touch with our sales department who will keep you up to date with all price movements.

Supply

This is an interesting topic and generally supply of most sections are in balance. However with summer holidays and mill closures, some popular sizes will be in short supply as they await mill rollings in September and October. Hollow sections are being affected by new quotas on Turkish supply and this will force prices up in the short term and there may be more shortages to come. The whole European and world markets are still recovering from the virus shut downs and there could be many more unforeseen twists and turns to come over the next few months.
